

Eligible Scouts for the Order of the Arrow.

For the Order of the Arrow election, a scout is eligible if:

- His rank is that of First Class or above and
- has completed 10 nights or more of overnight camps during the last two years. [Boy Scouts Camps] (Must include 5 contiguous nights) and
- be approved by the scoutmaster.
- Get 50% or more of the votes of those voting.

Also consider the 'Purpose' of the order of the Arrow when making your choice:

Purpose of the Order of the Arrow

- To recognize those campers - Scouts and Scouters - who best exemplify the Scout Oath and Law in their daily lives and by such recognition cause other scouts to conduct themselves in such a manner as to warrant recognition.
- To develop and maintain camping traditions and spirit.
- To promote Scout camping, which reaches its greatest effectiveness as a part of the unit's camping program, both year-round and in the summer camp, as directed by the camping committee.
- To crystallize the Scout habit of helpfulness into a life purpose of leadership in cheerful service to others.
